

Items purchased through a Baja Designs authorized dealer must be returned through the dealer. Only available on LED auxiliary lights and product must be in sellable condition at MSRP. 


Tacoma ('12 -'17) & Tundra ('14 -'18)









Step 1: Remove stock fog light by removing screws on outside edge. If equipped, you may want to unscrew the plastic wheel well shroud to gain access.

Note: Depending on vehicle year there may be a backsplash behind the light which will need to be removed.

Step 2: Bolt kit brackets onto Squadron lights as seen in the picture above being sure the angled bezels line up with the driver and passenger shrouds.

Note: Make sure serrated washers are in between the light housings and the four brackets.

Step 3: Included in the kit is two thicknesses of sticky back EPDM which is intended to be placed onto the ears of brackets 2 & 3. Cut the EPDM into ½" x ½" squares.

Note: Use the thicker EPDM for the Tundra and the thinner for the Tacoma.





Step 4: Tighten the lights onto vehicle with one of the factory screws.

Note: While tightening the screws gently push the light assembly inward to ensure alignment.

Note: Tacomas and Tundras will only have one factory screw. Tundras will have an additional bolt, nut, washers and rubber cap to dampen vibration as described in the following section.


Step 5: Use the included H-11 wiring adapters to plug into factory wiring being sure to check polarity of vehicle wiring prior to installing 2 pin connectors onto adapter.

Note: The Squadron light wiring polarity is as follows; white = positive, black = negative

The next set of steps pertain to only the **Toyota Tundra**

Step 1: Place a ¼" washer onto the included ¼"-20 x 1.75" long bolt and install bolt into the remaining slot, place another washer onto bolt then thread nyloc nut onto bolt fully tightening bolt to bracket. Finally, place rubber cap onto end of bolt as shown below.

Note: Removal of the entire shroud assembly from bumper and installing Squadron lights into them will better allow for aligning the bezels with the shroud and tightening the bolts properly.






Step 2: With the blue clip that holds the shroud onto bumper removed, place two strips of the thinner sticky back EPDM onto the bumper in the location shown and reinstall the clip. This will help secure the shroud to the bumper and reduce vibration.

Note: Be careful not to stress or break the plastic as this will be a snug fit. A small amount of silicone spray or WD-40 applied to top of EPDM will aide installation.







4Runner ('10-ON)



Note: Installation below was performed on a 2018 4Runner Limited. Other sub-model procedures may vary.

Step 1: Remove bolts from front and bottom of inner fender wells.







Step 2: With access behind inner fender wells remove one white clip and one screw holding left and right fog light shrouds onto bumper.



Step 3: Remove core support cover by removing the push clips.







Step 4: Remove the two remaining white clips holding fog light shrouds to bumper.








Step 5: Remove fog light shrouds and remove factory fog lamps keeping the factory screws which will be reused.

Step 6: Install sticky back EPDM onto kit brackets.



Step 7: Install brackets onto Squadrons and install into shrouds with factory fog light screws.

Note: The fitment will be snug, so a little silicone spray or WD-40 may be necessary on top of the EPDM to slide it in.



Step 8: Install shrouds with Squadrons onto vehicle the reverse of removal.

Step 9: Use the included wiring adapters to plug into factory wiring being sure to check polarity of vehicle wiring prior to installing 2 pin connectors onto adapter.
